

HATCHERY RD. BRIDGE OVER CLINTON RIVER WEST OF DIXIE HIGHWAY TO BE REPLACED IN 2022


The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Waterford Township, will replace the Hatchery Road bridge over the Clinton River between Dixie Highway and Frembes Road in 2022.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Removal and replacement of the existing bridge over the Clinton River.
- Removal and replacement of a culvert under the road west of the bridge.
- Removal of the existing wooden pedestrian bridge over the Clinton River and replacement with pedestrian facilities on the new bridge.
- Repaving of two-tenths miles of Hatchery Road with asphalt.
- Placement of curbs, gutters and guardrails.
- Upgrades to traffic signals at the Hatchery Road/Airport Road intersection.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Hatchery Road will be closed between Dixie Highway and Frembes Road during the project. Access to homes and businesses within the closure area, as well as to the Waterford Historical Society, will be maintained throughout the project.



During the closure, the detour route for through traffic will be Airport Road to Williams Lake Road to Dixie Highway and back to Hatchery and vice versa.

SCHEDULE

Utility relocation will take place in the winter and spring of 2022. Minor tree clearing will follow in March 2022, and construction will begin in July 2022. The project is expected to be completed in November of 2022.

PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project is expected to cost \$2.26 million. It is being paid for with federal funds and by RCOC.
